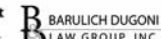

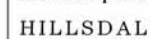

JUNE 17 THE B STARS – Honky Tonk/Hillbilly Swing
The B Stars will get the joint jumpin' and your toes tappin' with a good ol' dose of vintage country and hillbilly swing. Hailing from San Francisco with a back pocket of country songs and the desire to dust off old forgotten hillbilly tunes, The B Stars pay a courteous nod to the country and western stars of the late 1940's through the early 1960's. Formed in 2006 the band features original tunes that pay tribute to the likes of Johnny Cash, Hank Williams, and other great musicians of this era.



JULY 22 LEE WATERMAN JAZZ CALIENTE – Latin Jazz

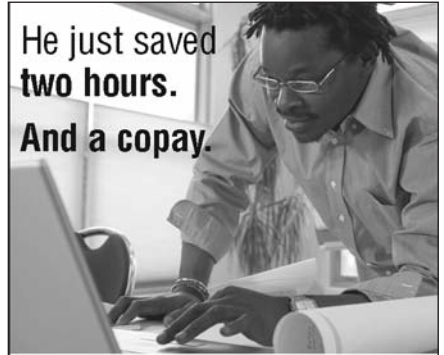

GREEN BIN = FOOD AND PAPER

Includes: All food (even bones!), all paper (plates, napkins, paper cups, newspapers, flyers, programs), dirty paper plates & pizza boxes. **NO** plastic lids, plastic plates or Styrofoam! (Those go in the **BLACK** Bin).

BLUE BIN = BOTTLES AND CANS

Includes: Water bottles (or any plastic bottle), soda cans (or any metal or aluminum cans), glass bottles (for example, Snapple, Pellegrino, or wine bottles) yogurt containers (dairy containers).

BLACK BIN = TRASH

Includes: Plastic plates, lids, straws, forks, knives, take-out containers, Styrofoam to-go boxes (or anything Styrofoam), take-out fountain soda cups, Saran Wrap.
